Subject: Resolution No. 72-27A3

**In Kind Services in the Public Education Enrichment Fund  
(Proposition H)**

**WHEREAS:** The Public Education Enrichment Fund (known as “Prop H”) represents a tremendous and growing investment of City resources in creating and expanding educational opportunities for students in the San Francisco Unified School District; and

**WHEREAS:** The San Francisco Board of Education is committed to continued and increased collaboration with the Mayor and the Board of Supervisors of San Francisco to comprehensively serve the needs of youth and families in San Francisco through Prop H and other resources; and

**WHEREAS:** Members of the Board of Supervisors have expressed a strong desire for the Board of Education to explore the possibility of requesting that an increased portion of Prop H resources be provided to the District in the form of in-kind services; and

**WHEREAS:** The Board of Education has established through resolution a process for developing an annual spending plan for Prop H funds, whereby a Community Advisory Committee on Proposition H develops a plan and forwards it to the Superintendent and the Board of Education for consideration.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** That the Board of Education includes not less than \$2.5 million of its 2008-2009 proposed Prop H spending plan as in-kind services from the City for purposes to be determined by the Community Advisory Committee on Proposition H in consultation with District staff and City and County of San Francisco departmental staff; and

**FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED:** That the Board formally requests that the Board of Supervisors agendaize a discussion of Proposition H, including a specific discussion of this resolution and of potential in-kind services, for the next meeting of the Select Committee of the Board of Supervisors and Board of Education.
